<b>Job Title:</b>	National Audit Project 6 (NAP 6) Steering Panel Member, Expert Anaesthetist (Perioperative Anaphylaxis)
<b>Directorate:</b>	Education & Research
<b>Responsible to:</b>	Professionally responsible to the NAP 6 Clinical Lead and the RCoA Director of NAPs Managerially responsible to the Director of Education and Research
<b>Main function:</b>	The expert anaesthetist will join the Steering Panel led by Professor Nigel Harper, NAP6 Clinical Lead

#### SPECIFIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

This will involve (but not be limited to):

- Attending regular steering/review panel meetings (approximately monthly for 18-24 months) at the RCoA
- Actively contributing to discussions relating to all aspects of the NAP6 process including the identification, management and investigation of perioperative anaphylaxis
- Reviewing and classifying anonymised case information reported to NAP6 at the RCoA
- Contributing to the analysis of data
- Engaging with and possibly leading subgroup projects within NAP6
- Writing/editing sections of NAP6 reports as requested (typically leading one chapter and contributing to 2-3 chapters)
- Contributing to NAP6 articles to be submitted to the British Journal of Anaesthesia and/or other relevant journals as requested
- A willingness to take a role in dissemination of the results of NAP6 would be desirable.

#### Note

All case review takes place at the RCoA. Steering and review panels run sequentially as required. Analysis and writing/editing generally take place between these meetings.
